

EPHOA Bus Ride Adventure to Columbia, PA

Let's explore the Susquehanna River and downtown Columbia, PA via the Red Rose Transit Authority busses.

We will meet at the parking lot at Mad Chef on Friday, April 12th at 9:00am
We will catch bus 19 across the street at about 9:16am.
We ride it to Queen Street station and arrive before 9:55am.
We then catch bus 17 at 10:20am to Columbia.
We arrive at Chestnut Street and 3rd Street in Columbia at about 11:10am.

We then will walk .4 miles down to the Columbia Crossing River Trail Center. Google says it's a 9 minute walk.

We will then catch bus 17 at the Locust and 3rd Street shelter (right past S. Market St) at 1:20pm.

We ride to the Queen Street station and arrive at 2:15pm.

We then catch bus 19 at 2:40pm and ride to East Petersburg at about 3:10pm.

I will be testing this trip on Friday April 5th and will then know how many seats will be available.
